## Rules of internship for practical study programmes at the Faculty of International and Political Studies of the University of Lodz

- 1. Students are required to complete internships, which result from the study programme for bachelor's degrees, in the amount of 720 hours:
  - National Security
  - International Cultural Studies
  - International Marketing

As well as on a master's degree, in the amount of 360 hours:

## International Cultural Studies

- 2. Internships are carried out by the student no later than by the end of the semester, each time specified in the study programme.
- 3. Students shall carry out internships based on:
  - the referral from the University of Lodz and the agreement concluded by the UL with the student's host institution at the request of the intern,
  - employment contract or a contract between the student and the host institution for the duration of the internship,
  - referral, if the internship is carried out at the home faculty.
- 4. The documents required for the start of the internship must be signed before the start of its implementation.
- 5. The internship supervisor shall **recognize the completion** of the student's internship by making a note in the internship report and the internship book, after the submission of a set of documents in the original (referral, agreement, internship book and report). The internship recognition is included in the USOSweb.
- 6. In the case of refusal of recognition of the internship by the faculty supervisor, the student should receive a written justification of the decision, which the student may appeal to the Vice-Dean for Student Affairs.
