The student research journal from a visit to a UNIC partner university should contain detailed and reflective records of experiences, observations, and knowledge gained during the stay.

Below are the elements that should be included in such a journal:

Purpose of the visit:

Description of the main academic and personal goals related to the visit.

Cultural and social observations:

Notes on local traditions, customs, and daily life.

Reflections on cultural similarities and differences compared to one's own country.

Analyses and Reflections.

Critical assessment of artworks, architecture, or other cultural forms encountered:

Reflections on the impact of new experiences on one's own views and knowledge. Visits and Excursions.

Description of museums, galleries, historical, and cultural sites visited during the stay:

Collected impressions and visual notes (e.g., sketches, photos with descriptions).

Meetings and networking:

Information on meetings with professors, students, and specialists in the field:

Description of discussions, exchange of views, and acquired knowledge.

Personal development:

Reflections on language skill development, adaptation to a new environment, and independence. Personal thoughts on life abroad and intercultural experiences.











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Documentation and materials:

Scans or photos of notes, leaflets, brochures that may be useful in further research.

Bibliography of books, articles, and other sources used during the visit.

Conclusions and future plans:

Summary of the most important takeaways from the visit.

Plans regarding the application of acquired knowledge in further studies or career.
