How can I pass the exams? Is it the same as in the previous stages of education?

Yes and no. The academic year consists of two semesters, every semester ends with an examination session. If you successfully take all your courses, your semester is passed. The university grading scale is from 2 to 5. The 5 is the highest grade that You can get and 2 means a failure. The lowest positive grade that you can get is 3. Remember that participation in all classes is obligatory and absences must be excused. The lecturers may require a number of different activities from students during the semester for example: written assignment, presentations, projects, filming or creating.

What is an annual higher education students' holiday (Juwenalia)?

Usually a holiday takes place in May and good music of Polish and international singers and bands is guaranteed.

How can I develop my academic passions?

All BA students should complete physical education classes in the second and third semester of studies (two semesters). Physical education is a compulsory course with a grade.

Enrolment for physical education classes takes place on the USOS platform using a token registration. A student receives one token which allows them to choose the discipline.
